Our Commitment

Cheshire East Filipino Community is committed to providing a safe, welcoming and inclusive environment for children and young people attending our activities and events.

Scope

This policy applies to committee members, volunteers, contractors and anyone acting on behalf of CEFC.

Our Principles

The welfare of every child comes first. We treat all children with dignity and respect, listen to concerns, and take appropriate action where there is a safeguarding concern.

What We Do

We provide safeguarding guidance to volunteers, identify a safeguarding lead for major events, assess risks, and work with emergency services or statutory agencies where required.

Reporting a Concern

If a child is at immediate risk, call 999. Any safeguarding concern at a CEFC event should be reported immediately to the Event Lead or a Committee Member. Concerns will be taken seriously and handled appropriately.

Photography

Images of children are used responsibly and in accordance with the CEFC Photography & Filming Policy.
